



Overview

Falls are the leading cause of death among construction workers; and in construction were due to falls from roofs over an 18-year period. CPWR researchers look at the Bureau of Labor Statistics Occupational Injuries and Illnesses data using employment numbers from the Census Bureau's Current Population Survey. This study identifies patterns and trends among construction workers and links them to injury prevention real applications for the industry.
